BASIC STRUCTURE:

- WHO is the story about?
- WHAT is the story about?
- WHERE did it happen?
- WHEN did it take place?
- WHY did it happen?



GOOD QUOTES:

Write down some good quotes to record opinions and emotions as these will make your report more interesting.

Remember to use quotation marks in written reports.



RESEARCH YOUR SUBJECT

Make sure you research your subject first so that you are able to tell it in your own words. It will also help you to ask relevant questions during interviews.
